#### **Project Progress for the Month of April**

#### A. <u>Highlights of the month:</u>

- Harbor Brook Interceptor Sewer Replacement Project. Project will receive ARRA stimulus monies. The construction contract is with J.J. Lane. The construction cost is \$12,217,888. Notice to Proceed was issued on November 25, 2009. Construction is underway and is scheduled to be completed this year.
- ACJ required projects are proceeding with evaluations, reports, final designs and construction.
- DEC Commissioner Pete Grannis joined County Executive Joanne Mahoney in celebrating Earth Day with a joint announcement about continued programs to clean Onondaga Lake.
- The EPA honored Onondaga County, The Onondaga Nation, Atlantic States Legal Foundation and the Partnership for Onondaga Creek with the Environmental Quality Award for their collaboration in developing and introducing green infrastructure solutions into the clean-up of Onondaga Lake.
- During the month of April, presentations on the County's Green Infrastructure program were given to the following organizations:
  - University Hill Corporation on April 8.
  - SUNY Upstate Medical Center on April 9.
  - Crouse Marshall Business Improvement District on April 15.
- The County also kicked off a pilot rain barrel program on the South and West sides of the City of Syracuse. The pilot program will provide free rain barrels for residents to capture stormwater on their properties. The program received a grant from EFC.
- The County has continued close collaboration with the City of Syracuse on the development of a "green" parking lot program with the first scheduled for the Downtown Farmer's Market. Construction of the Farmer's Market lot will begin in May.
- The **skimmer boat operation** began the first week of April 2010. Under the contract with Waste Resources, Inc., the boat will collect and remove debris once weekly during the months of April and May. The first event scheduled at the Inner Harbor is on May 8.

#### **B.** Progress of Projects Under Construction

#### **Harbor Brook Interceptor Replacement**

State allocated \$20m for Interceptor Sewer Replacement and Culvert work

• Construction is proceeding. 2837 feet of interceptor pipe has been installed, 2300 feet of sanitary sewer pipe has been installed, and 290 feet of storm sewer has been installed. Project is scheduled to be substantially complete in 2010 with final restoration in Spring 2011.

#### C. Projects in Design Stage

#### Midland Phase III (CSO)

• A contract agreement is being finalized for engineering services to proceed with the facilities planning for CSO's 052 (Hunt and Elmhurst) and 060/077 (West Colvin) in the Midland area. Design is in progress for completion of a smaller conveyance to connect CSO 044 (South Ave and West Castle).

#### **Clinton CSO Abatement**

- Design is in progress for a large storage facility in the Trolley Lot. A contract agreement is being finalized for engineering services to proceed with the facilities plan for 027 (West Fayette) and 029 (Walton).
- CSO's 022 (West Genesee) sewer separation project design to be finalized.

The goal of the Clinton project is to address the abatement of 11 CSO's between Fayette and Oneida Streets located near downtown Syracuse.

#### **Harbor Brook CSO Abatement**

Design is in progress for a large storage facility in the Harbor Brook Sewershed near State Fair Blvd.

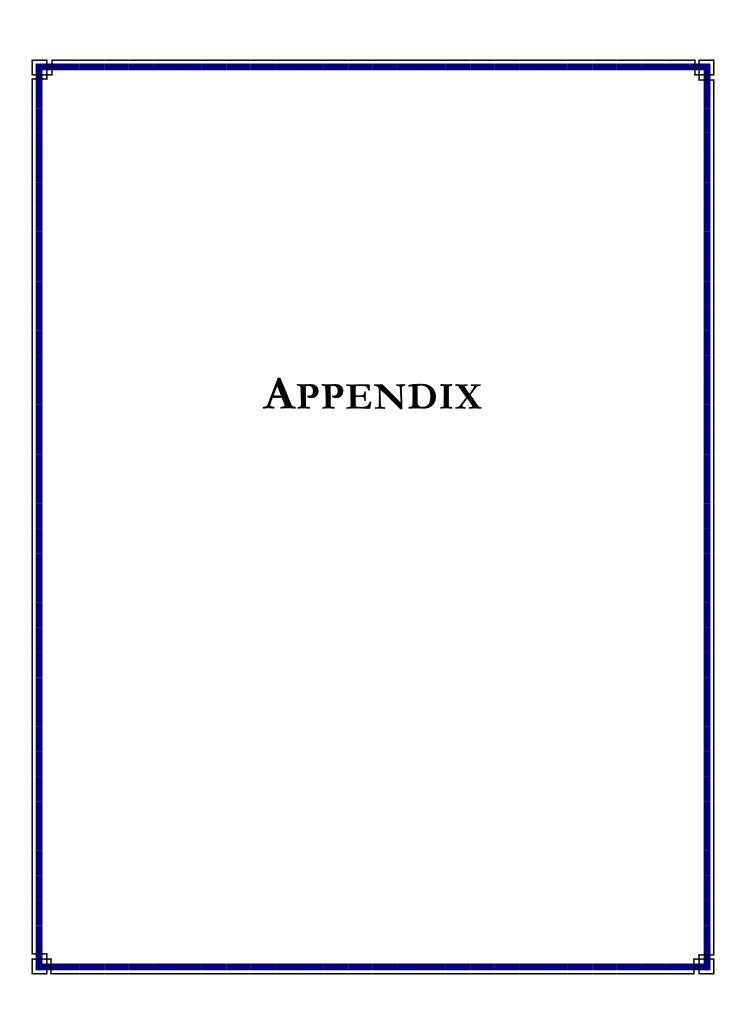
