#### **Project Progress for the Month of March**

#### A. <u>Highlights of the month:</u>

- Harbor Brook Interceptor Sewer Replacement Project. Project was advertised for bidding on September 29, 2009. The project is slated to receive ARRA stimulus monies with very tight timelines. Three bids were received on November 2, 2009. The apparent low bid was from J.J. Lane at \$12,217,888. Notice to Proceed was issued on November 25, 2009. Construction is underway.
- **Revisions to the ACJ**. The Fourth Stipulation to the ACJ was signed by Judge Scullin and filed on November 16, 2009. Preparation for upcoming work is progressing with six RFP issuances. Proposals have been received, reviewed and awarded on schedule for required projects. Projects are proceeding with final designs for construction.

During the month of March, presentations on the County's Green Infrastructure program were given to the following organizations:

The County also participated in the following local events:

- CNY Home & Garden Show on March 18-21.
- CNY Chamber of Commerce Business Show on March 25.

In addition, County Executive Joanne Mahoney announced the creation of the Green Improvement Fund (GIF) to provide grant assistance to private business owners/501c3 organizations for the implementation of green infrastructure programs at the State of the County Address on March 2.

Additionally, the County has continued close collaboration with the City of Syracuse on implementation of the green plan and has identified potential demonstration projects.

• The **skimmer boat operation** will begin the first week of April 2010. Under the contract with Waste Resources, Inc., the boat will collect and remove debris once weekly during the months of April and May. The first event scheduled at the Inner Harbor is on May 8.

#### **B.** Progress of Projects Under Construction

#### **Harbor Brook Interceptor Replacement**

State allocated \$20m for Interceptor Sewer Replacement and Culvert work

- The County requested monies from the State EFC to construct a much needed replacement for a large portion of the Harbor Brook Interceptor Sewer between Velasko Road and Fayette St. Replacement of the interceptor was included in the Harbor Brook RTF and Conveyances project and was nearly fully designed. The interceptor sewer replacement project was "shovel ready", all environmental reviews were done and the project was already on the State Intended Use Plan. The County will receive \$20million in state funds (\$10m in grants and \$10m in low interest loan) for this project.
- County Legislature approved cost increase and bonding authorization for this project and additional green infrastructure work, repairs to the Harbor Brook culvert and Harbor Brook Floatables Control Facility totaling \$26m at its June 2 meeting.
- Design documents needed for this revised project were submitted to DEC for review on August 17, 2009.
- The Construction Project was Advertised on September 29, 2009.
- Bids were opened on November 2, 2009.
- Notice to Proceed was issued on November 25, 2009.
- Construction is proceeding. 2500 feet of interceptor pipe has been installed, 1632 feet of sanitary sewer pipe has been installed, and 260 feet of storm sewer has been installed.

#### C. Projects in Design Stage

#### Midland Phase III (CSO)

• A facilities planning proposal has been received for CSO's 052 (Hunt and Elmhurst) and 060/077 (West Colvin) in the Midland area. Design is in progress for completion of a smaller conveyance to connect CSO 044 (South Ave and West Castle).

#### **Clinton CSO Abatement**

• Design is in progress for a large storage facility in the Trolley Lot. A facilities plan proposal has been received for CSO's 022 (West Genesee), 027 (West Fayette) and 029 (Walton).

The goal of the Clinton project is to address the abatement of 11 CSO's between Fayette and Oneida Streets located near downtown Syracuse.

#### **Harbor Brook CSO Abatement**

Design is in progress for a large storage facility in the Harbor Brook Sewershed near State Fair Blvd.


