

Note: DELTFM are defined as <u>Deformities</u>, <u>Erosions</u>, <u>Lesions</u>, <u>Tumors</u>, <u>Fungus</u>, and/or <u>Malignancies</u>. The increase in recent years is mostly due to an increase in the brown bullhead catch and a higher proportion of those brown bullhead having skin lesions. Analysis by Cornell University of Onondaga Lake bullhead in 2008 found a variety of pathogens including: *Trichodina*, *Saprolegnia*, *Digenean* infestations, *Micrococcus luteus*, and *Aeromonas sobria*.
