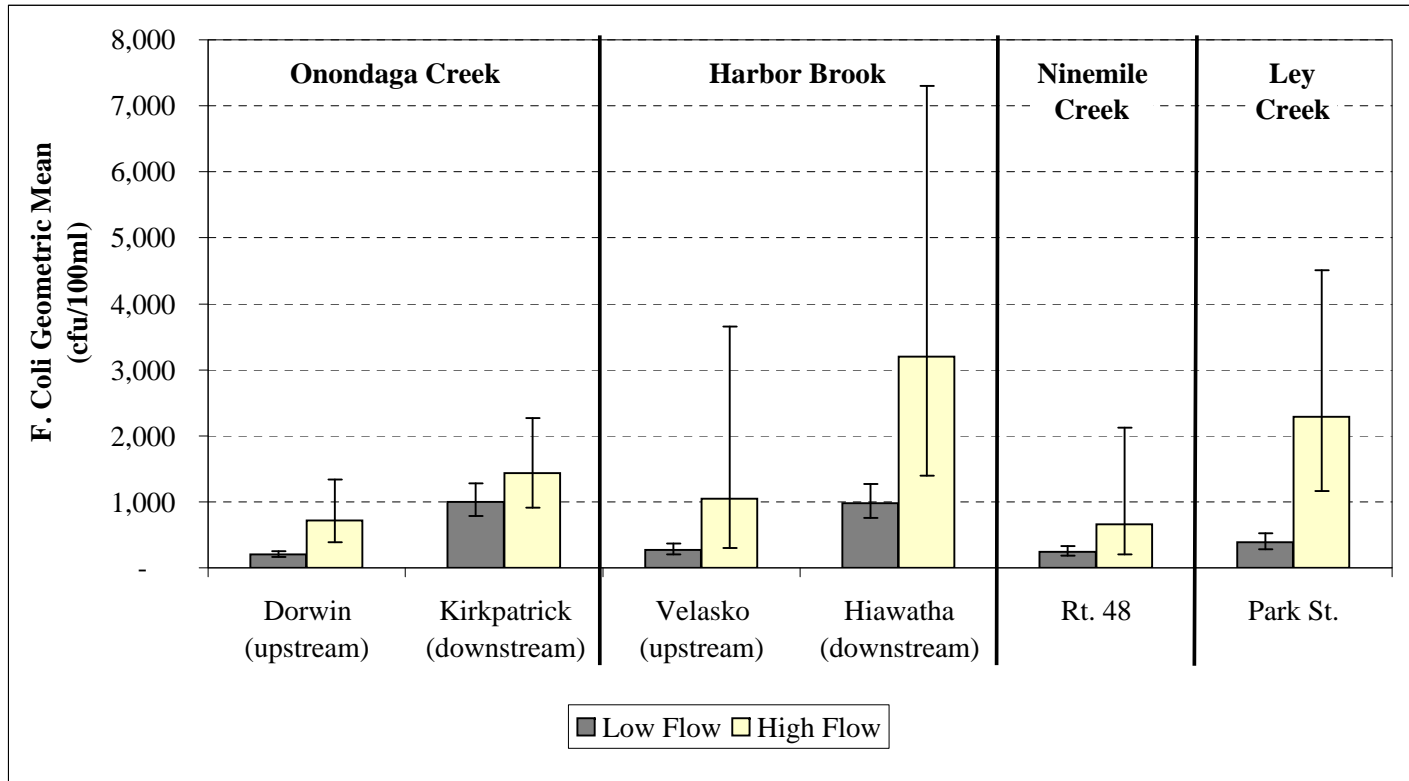

Fecal coliform bacteria (geometric mean and 95% confidence interval) for the summer period June to September (1999-2008), showing low flow and high flow statistics by monitoring site. Low flow represents samples collected when daily average flow was less than or equal to the long-term monthly average flow. High flow represents samples collected when daily average flow was greater than one standard deviation above the monthly average flow. (As there were no samples collected when daily flows met the low flow definition at Onondaga Creek/Kirkpatrick site in 2000 and 2006, samples with flow less than 100 cfs were used.)
