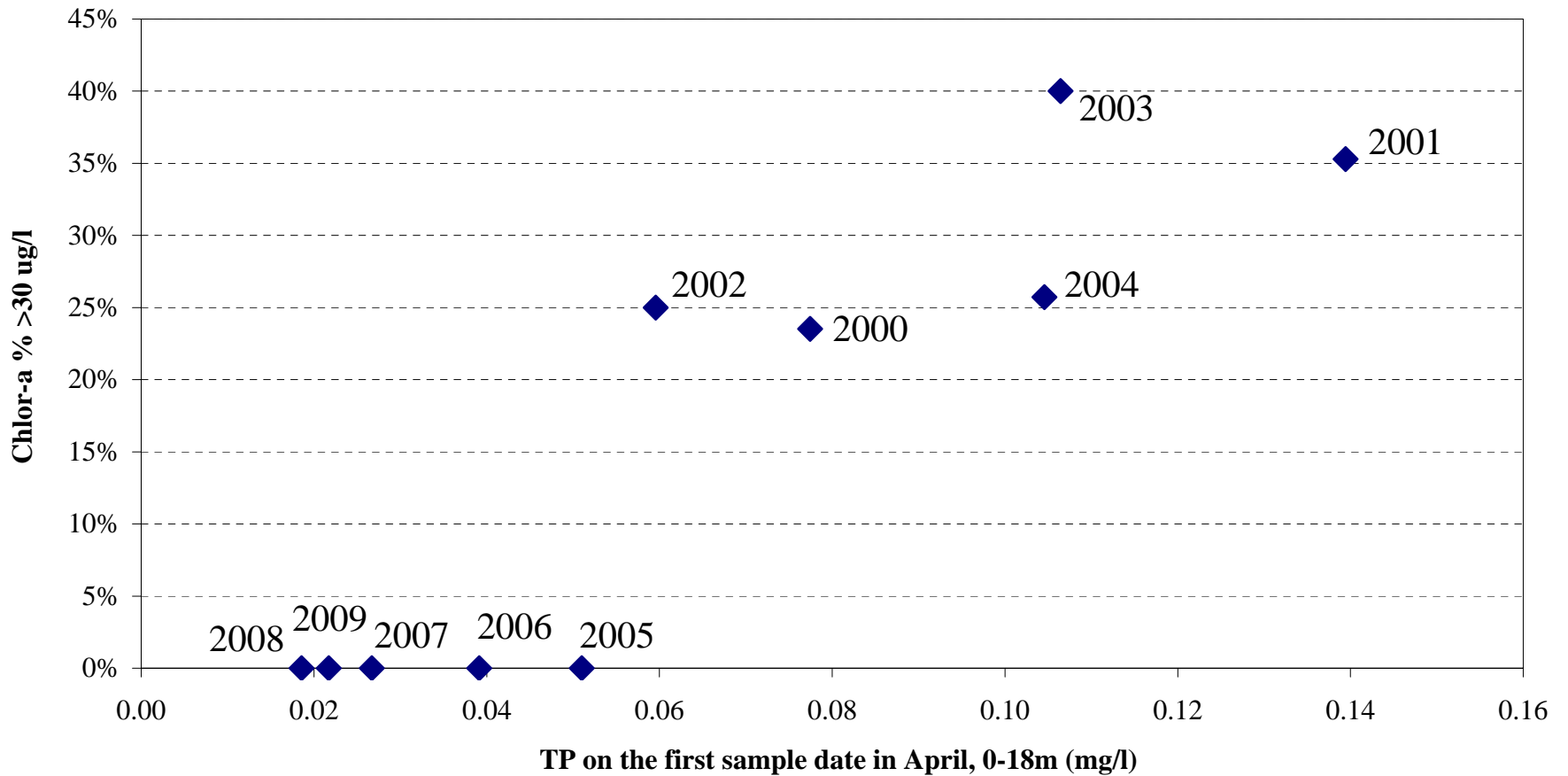

Relationship over ten years between spring total phosphorus (TP) concentration (averaged across sample depths from 0 to 18 meters) and the frequency of summertime nuisance algal blooms at South Deep station in Onondaga Lake. Summertime nuisance algal blooms are defined as concentrations of chlorophyll-a exceeding 30 ug/l for the period from June through September.
